campaign	An organised action to achieve a goal
discrimination	Unjust/unkind treatment of a group of people
equality	The state of being equal in status, rights and opportunities
feminism	Support of women's rights
prejudice	An opinions that is not based on reason or actual experience
pioneer	A person who is amongst the first to explore (physically or in research)
racism	Prejudice or discrimination against a person or people of a particular race or ethnic group
segregation	Setting someone or something apart from others
sexism	Prejudice or discrimination against a person or people of a particular sex (male or female)
suffragette	A woman seeking the right to vote through organised protest
vote	A choice in an election
