Discussion mainly on progress of summer fayre preparation.

JF expressed her disappointment that the 9 foot banner outside the school grounds had been destroyed after 2 days of being up. Confirmed we will put a bed sheet banner up on the day of the fayre and A4 laminated posters around the area. 2 small banners remain in place.

JF handed members a list of all stalls we are running and the names of the helpers running them, for information purposes. We have had a good response from the LSAs with most of them volunteering to help in one way or another.

Unfortunately Crookhorn College contacted JR and confirmed they were unable to help with music this time. Therefore agreed music will be played via CD in playground/indoors.

The Just Different logo has been put on the collection bucket and JF has bought 2 smaller collection buckets for the parade. All money collected from the parade will go to Just Different, money collected at the school will go towards the PTA funds (for new picnic benches).

Leaflets were handed to KP, NO, KH to hand deliver. NO to place small leaflets in Subway tomorrow.

DL confirming we shall have 3 or 4 slow cookers and all have been PAT tested. DL confirmed we have CD players and CD box available to use as well as plenty of extension leads.

JF has ordered the hot dog rolls from Tesco and will collect them Thursday morning.

KP suggested sweeteners for the tea and coffee stall also.

We have arranged a last minute book sale table for the fayre, which has plenty of books for this time. Will do book sale tables at future events as it is easy way to raise money.

The non uniform day was a success with over 150 items being donated to the school tombola, and we now have in excess of 200 items for the stall!

JF and NO attended St Johns School Fete in Rowlands Castle at the weekend and booked "Martin Roundabout" who has a hand cranked carousel, to attend our fayre. He will pay a pitch fee and charge a fee for a ride.

DL confirmed paper plates will be sent out on Monday for students to fill with cakes for Friday.

JF confirming the Portsmouth News will attend and focus mainly on the parade; if he has time he will attend the fayre and take photos but he is happy to have photos emailed across to him after the event (contact is Jeff at Havant office). He has confirmed he will attend the school at 1 pm.
