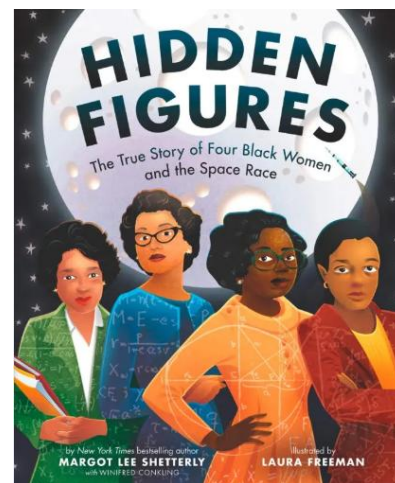
This term we have been learning about our new topic- Hidden Figures.
